TIME: 9:00 A.M.

This show is to better help riders prepare for the County Fair. We are having this show at the **St. Mary's County Fairgrounds**. The Fairgrounds are located on Route 5, 2 miles south of Leonardtown. From Route 2/4 travel south on Route 4 to its end. Turn left on Route 5. Go about 1 mile to the Fairgrounds on the left. Use the entrance by the FASTOP.

**RULES**

1. Pre-entries (due Wednesday before show) are \$10.00. Post entries are \$14.00 per class.
2. Six ribbons in each class and champion and reserve awards in each division.
3. Hardhats are required at all times when mounted. Juniors must wear USEF approved helmets.
4. In preparation for the Fair, all animals (**EXCEPT** Leadline and Walk/Trot) should be braided. **All** riders should be in proper show attire.
5. There will be Flat schooling **ONLY** in the ring between 7:30 - 8:30 a.m. and during the lunch break between Classes 23 and 24, which will be no earlier than 1:00 p.m. (at the Fair, you are allowed to walk only in the ring before the show and during the lunch break).
6. Negative Coggins test within one year required at entry desk.
7. Refreshments will be sold on the grounds.
8. Seniors may ride ponies.
9. In case of poor weather or further questions, call (301) 475-5434.
10. Please **DO NOT** let your animal graze around the buildings or fences -- these areas may be sprayed with weed killer.

**DIVISIONS**

**LEADLINE** - open to all riders 8 years and under. Judged on rider's position and suitability of mount. Not eligible for any other classes except Walk.

**WALK/TROT** (small/medium ponies) - open to riders on small/medium ponies who do not wish to canter. Pony/rider combo may not enter any other classes except Green Rider. Courses to be trotted. Jumps 12".

**WALK/TROT** (large ponies/horses) - open to riders on large ponies/horses who do not wish to canter. Horse/pony/rider combo may not enter any other classes except Green Rider. Courses to be trotted. Jumps 12".

**GREEN RIDER** - this is an Equitation Division designed to "bridge the gap" between the walk/trot divisions and the canter divisions. It is open to riders on horses or ponies. The same horse/pony/rider combo may not enter any other classes except Walk/Trot or Short Stirrup. Jumps may be trotted or cantered. Jumps 12".

**SHORT STIRRUP** - open to riders 12 years and under on horses or ponies. Courses to be cantered. Riders may not enter Equitation. Jumps 18".

**EVERGREEN PONY HUNTER** - open to ponies and riders not ready for the regular divisions. Same pony/rider combo may not enter Pony Hunter. Jumps 18", courses may be trotted or cantered, flat class will include the canter.

**PONY PLEASURE** - open to all ponies. Jumps 18" or 2' - your choice. The pairs class has been added to this division.

**PONY HUNTER** - open to all ponies. Jumps 2' or 2'6" - your choice.

**EQUITATION** - open to all ponies and horses. Ponies to jump 2', horses to jump 2'6".

**A.M.I.T. MEDAL** - Open to riders who have pinned (1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>) in any class of an Equitation Division in one of the AMIT Schooling Shows (including Equitation classes in this Show). There will be two phases, a jumping course and a test. The course will consist of a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction and may include a combination. Jumps to be 2' for small and medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, and 2'9" for horses. Up to ten entrants selected by judge will be called back to perform an Equitation Test.

**HORSE HUNTER** - open to all horses. Jumps 2'6" or 3' - your choice.

**EVERGREEN HORSE HUNTER** - open to horses and riders not ready for the regular divisions. Same horse/rider combo may not enter Horse Hunter. Jumps 2', courses may be trotted or cantered, flat class will include the canter.

**HORSE PLEASURE** - open to all horses. Jumps 2' or 2'6" - your choice. The pairs class has been added to this division.
